

Feb 25/98 NSg Note at 1905 - Pt. need. at 0825 c̄ pain
scale 3/10. P/O Tyf c̄ Codeine 30mg given at 0740. VSS, afebrile
Bowel sounds present - eating + + +; pizza, chocolate,
chips, pudding, chocolate bars. On many occasions
during shift, writer looked in Pt.'s window and pt
appeared to be playing c̄ no distress, eating c̄ no distress
as soon as pt. noticed writer, expression of pain appears
and when writer opens door, pt moans. Pt. reports
anterior tibia from patella to ankle ^{from} pains as
well as a little to the left of the tibia. Reports pain
to be worse at 1130 in the morning. When asked if pain
travelled to any other part of her body, she said,
"No, just to where I pointed, right here." Cast is dry
and intact, toes are nice and warm, able to move on
command. Femoral pulse is present and strong.
Regular Tylenol given at 1540, by 1600 pain decreased,
and at 1625 had decreased from 7/10 to 3/10. Up to w/R
at 1800, c/o severe pain - 7.4/10, Codeine 30mg given c̄
good effect. A → Pain ?? P → Bone Scan Tomorrow - Janice
P → Continue to assess pain level, document strategies,
continue to add to plan. Janice RN.

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
